

**8** — **Additional FLORIDA GROSS RECEIPTS TAX**

The Florida Gross Receipts Tax cost recovery applies to the Electric Surcharge.

$$\$6.42 \times 0.025641 = \$0.16$$

This amount is added to the Florida Gross Receipts Tax from step 6.

$$\$3.21 + \$0.16 = \quad \quad \quad \mathbf{\$ 3.37}$$

Gross Receipts Tax applied to Surcharge on Gross Receipts Tax which is applied to Gross Receipts Tax

**9** — **COUNTY UTILITY TAX\*\***

The sum of steps 1, 2, 3, 4, 7 and 8 is subject to a 10% County Utility Tax for customers living outside the city.

$$\$11.90 + \$9.75 + \$25.00 + \$14.38 + \$6.42 + \$3.37 = \$70.82$$

$$\$70.82 \times 0.10 = \quad \quad \quad \mathbf{\$ 7.08}$$

\*\*\* County Utility Tax applied to purchases of Electric, Gas & Water outside the municipal boundaries and is also applied to pyramided Gross Receipts Tax & Surcharge taxing .025641 of the "Fuel Adjustment Charge" Twice (total of .051282)  
Effective Rate: Slightly lowered outside the city (approximately between 15% and 11.5% for a consumption between 1500 and 500 kwh)
